UK charity **Smart Works** will open a pop-up at 57 Carnaby Street, following successful previous pop-ups in Covent Garden last year. Running 1st - 24th March, to coincide with **International Women's Day**, the pop-up will create an experiential shopping experience for visitors with an exciting lineup of fashion, homeware, childrenswear, accessory and beauty brands with 100% of the proceeds raised from the pop-up going directly to the charity. The pop-up will also have a full schedule of panel talks and brand collaborations alongside the curated retail offer, which will be announced very soon.

There will also be a variety of pieces kindly donated from well-known individuals including Fearne Cotton, Dame Shirley Bassey, Grayson Perry and celebrity stylist Sinead.

Smart Works uses the power of high quality clothing and one-to-one coaching to help unemployed women fulfil their potential and secure a job which will transform their lives. The charity's 11 centres across the UK provide career coaching, interview dressing and preparation services and 'The Smart Works Network' for further professional development opportunities. In 2023, Smart Works pop-ups raised over £150,000 which was put back into helping women achieve their professional goals.

Kate Stephens, CEO of Smart Works said: "Smart Works is a charity built on the power of community, and harnessing fashion as a force for good to help women transform their lives. This is a belief we share with Carnaby Street and Shaftesbury Capital, and we are grateful to the team for giving us the opportunity to host the next Smart Works Pop Up Shop over a key moment in our year – International Women's Day. With their ongoing support, we will be able to raise vital funds and visibility, enabling us to reach more women and connect them to their potential."
