- Covent Garden, London's most festive destination, has unveiled a line-up of activities throughout December bringing even more Christmas cheer to the capital this Holiday season
- The neighbourhood has welcomed back its famous **snowfall** delivering daily festive flurries to visitors in December, from midday to 9pm
- This year, Covent Garden has proudly partnered with **Save The Children** to create a one-of-a-kind popup for Christmas Jumper Day, with fundraising moments taking place throughout the season
- The neighbourhood has also launched **Festive Thursdays**, a programme of magical events and exclusive offers taking place every Thursday in the run-up to Christmas. This will include live performances from the **London International Gospel Choir**
- Covent Garden will once again celebrate its Christmas Sandwich Festival, from 7th 17th December, including offers from Ole & Steen, WatchHouse, Seven Dials Market, Apple Butter Café, newly opened Breakfast Club and more
- Foodies and partygoers will be spoilt for choice with exclusive Christmas and New Year's Eve menus and events across the estate, including **Balthazar**, **Frenchie**, **Mrs Riot**, **Stereo**, **Story Cellar**, and more
- Festive haven Miracle at Henrietta has returned, as brand new food and drink experience The Gingerbread Hut pops up on the Piazza

Covent Garden, London's most festive destination, will dial up the Christmas magic this December with a programme of exciting events, exclusive pop-ups, unbeatable shopping and dining experiences all running until the new year. From 1st December Covent Garden will mark the return of its much-loved daily **snowfall**, with hourly flurries taking place in front of the iconic 60ft Christmas tree from midday – 9pm. The estate will provide the perfect festive backdrop this December with the new decorative scheme continuing to dazzle across the Market Building and the festive lights sparkling daily from 11am – 11pm until 7th January 2024. For Christmas 2023, the neighbourhood will unveil a pop-up shop in partnership with charity **Save The Children** in celebration of **Christmas Jumper Day.** '*The Story Knit Store*' will be live from 1st - 7th December at 5-7 Short's Gardens, and will stock pre-loved jumpers donated by vintage retailer Beyond Retro, aiming to tackle the '*fast fashion*' throwaway approach to festive jumpers. The jumpers will be priced at £30 each, with **100%** of proceeds going to Save the Children's work in the UK and across the globe. Donations will also be available to make via the scannable tree decorations in the **Wonder Wood** on James Street along with further information and volunteers throughout the Piazza and surrounding streets up to Seven Dials.

For visitors seeking the ultimate Christmas experience, Covent Garden has introduced 'Festive Thursdays', a line-up of unforgettable events, offers and surprise and delight moments taking place every Thursday until Christmas. The weekly moments will include performances from The London International Gospel Choir in the Wonder Wood and at Neal's Yard, as well as bespoke food and drink offers at Lima Cantina, Din Tai Fung, Frenchie, VyTA, Ladurée, STEREO, Compagnie de Vins Surnaturels, Neuhaus and Da Henrietta. Guests can also enjoy special late-night shopping at Whittard, Mr Jones Watches, Astley Clarke, Sacred Gold, Benjamin Pollock's Toyshop and Experimental Perfume Club, as well as exclusive deals and shopping events at Jo Malone London, Aesop, Molton Brown, Ace & Tate, Olivia Burton and Strathberry. Covent Garden has announced a variety of festive activities perfect for the entire family this December. From 8th December – 3rd January. The Gingerbread Hut will pop up on the East Piazza where visitors can relax in life-sized gingerbread huts whilst enjoying a variety of alcoholic and non-alcoholic festive tipples, including a Gingerbread Heaven cocktail, Bailey's hot chocolate and mulled wine. Sweet festive treats such as warm brownies, churros and mince pies as well as gingerbread cookies and candy canes will be available too.

From now - 4th January the **London Transport Museum** will allow children to enter for free, giving families the opportunity to take a festive selfie with Santa and his elf. Visitors can also cosy up for Christmas stories in the den, get creative with holiday crafts and enjoy an immersive story trail. Furthermore, the **Royal Opera House** has announced a programme of magical experiences throughout December, including the launch of the Christmas Shop, new '*Christmas Cracker Family Sunday'*, '*The Making of The Nutcracker Tour*' and stunning performances of The Royal Ballet's '*The Nutcracker*'.

This Christmas, Covent Garden is brighter than ever before with over 140,000 LED lights illuminating the Piazza, Seven Dials and surrounding streets, with over 30,000 LED lights adorning the iconic British-grown, handpicked 60ft Christmas tree. The new decorative scheme features over 40 giant gold bells with red and gold glittering bows adorning the inside of the iconic Market Building, alongside the much-loved spinning mirror balls and giant red baubles. A team of 70 people have spent the last 18 months creating these unique pieces in a London based studio, with the bells weighing almost five tonnes, sparkling with 275 kilos of glitter, and glistening with an amount of gold leaf that's equivalent to a distance of 29 miles if laid out side by side.

In celebration of the most wonderful time of the year, Covent Garden will once more celebrate the annual **Christmas Sandwich Festival**, from 7th – 17th December. Visitors will be able to choose unique takes on the Christmas favourite - from festive focaccia turkey toasties at **Ole & Steen** to smoked bacon and stuffing sandwiches with gravy mayonnaise at **WatchHouse. Apple Butter Café** will be offering a traditional roast chicken Christmas sandwich, whilst **Stakehaus** at **Seven Dials Market** will be serving their Christmas sub special of roast beef with mulled wine cranberry sauce. A festive pulled pork sandwich is on offer at **Hot Rocket's** Cuban street food bar at **Seven Dials Market**, and the recently opened **Breakfast Club** will be adding 'The Christmas Camemburger' to their menu, consisting of a deep-fried camembert, parsnip & sprout crisps and cranberry mayo served in toasted focaccia. For something sweet, a warm 'Churros & Belgium Chocolate' sandwich will be available at **The Gingerbread Hut** pop-up on the East Piazza.
