For the best fluffy pittas filled with mediterranean flavour, **Miznon** has a selection of mouth watering dishes such as the Original Whole Cauliflower, the Lamb Kebab filled with sensual seasoned meat together with grilled tomato and onions closed with tahini and pickles. Or try **Maresco** for Spanish dishes curated with fresh Scottish produce. For a late night spot discover **Speedboat Bar** which serves drinks and snacks throughout the evening.

Discover the taste of modern day Jerusalem in a beautiful setting, **The Palomar** is every foodie's heaven featuring dishes such as Chimichurri Ribeye, grilled broccoli served with Laban Kishk and Chirshi and fresh bright salads.
